Yoni Medhin, a San Antonio inventor, will be presenting his Grain4Grain's patent pending innovative process for converting spent waste grains from breweries into healthy low carb, high protein sustainable flour products. The Keto-Friendly products are already having a positive impact on food scarcity and reduction of landfill waste. Yoni will discuss how the innovative products were conceived, developed, patent pending protected and commercialized. He will also discuss how he has been very successful in getting the flour products marketed by a high volume retailer.

Mr. Medhin, is the Co-Founder of Grain4Grain, www.grain4grain.com, a local Agri-tech startup launched in 2019, which has built an energy efficient granary, that converts the waste byproduct into their flour and flour mix products. Grain4Grain products are now marketed in nearly 200 HEB stores.

Yoni is a Denver, CO native who graduated from the Colorado School of Mines in 2016 and has a background in project economics and facilities engineering. Grain4Grain recently won the 2020 Food Start Up Of The Year Award in San Antonio.
