In 2008, he founded SegSaddle LLC in San Antonio for the purpose of developing aftermarket seating systems for the Segway Personal Transporter to make it of more use to handicapped people.

Mr. Hughes received his BS degree in mechanical engineering from MIT and his MBA from Harvard Business School. In 1984, he built the first privately funded transatlantic fiber cable system linking New York to London. He was also CEO of the American Rocket Company which provided rocket technology used on Burt Rutan’s SpaceShip One, winner of the X-Prize. 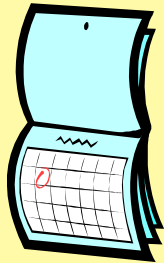
