Between the ages of 16 and 19, he helped his sister develop a thriving home bridal distributorship which marketed in 10 states and had annual revenues of \$2 million. Robert started inventing at 18 and developed a tri-pod luggage caddy but not knowing about intellectual property and marketing another large company was first to market. Robert's first invention break came when he realized compact shopping carts did not exist in supermarkets. He immediately, developed drawings, had prototypes made and applied for a patent which was subsequently issued. At the age of 26 he had made millions in combined sales and royalties from the express shopping cart invention. The shopping cart is found in most HEB PLUS stores and in 11 other supermarket chains throughout the US. With money from the shopping cart invention, Robert developed a novel electronic fishing lure marketed through his company Livingston Lures, www.livingstonlures.com, The croaking sound lures are sold throughout the US in major sporting goods chains and at Walmart. Mr. Castaneda is presently developing an infection prevention system scheduled for delivery to hospitals in 2014.

Robert served in the Air Force during Desert Storm and later worked in the Coronary Care Unit at Wilford Hall Medical Center. Also, he has served as an inventor consultant for various companies.
