



AI & Patents - Navigating a Brave New World Samar Shah, Patent Attorney

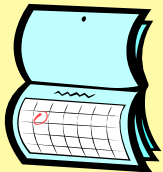

He wrote his first patent on a machine learning system in 2009, and since then, he has written patents for Google, Facebook and many other technology companies. Additionally, Samar has litigated patent lawsuits in the courtroom for clients such as Blackberry, AT&T, KCI/Acelity and Thermogenesis. He blends his patent prosecution and patent litigation experience to help clients develop strategic patent portfolios that can stand up in court.
