Mark Andrew Skousen is an American economist, investment analyst, newsletter editor, college professor and author. Like Dr. Franklin, he has been the author of an almanac, editor of a financial publication, successful entrepreneur, and a public servant. He earned his Ph.D. in monetary economics from George Washington University in 1977. Currently he holds the Benjamin Franklin Chair of Management at Grantham University.

He taught economics and finance at Columbia Business School. He was a Central Intelligence Agency analyst, a Forbes magazine columnist, and Foundation for Economic Education past president. He has written for the Wall Street Journal, Forbes, and the Christian Science Monitor, and has made regular appearances on CNBC's Kudlow & Co. and C-SPAN Book TV. His bestsellers include The Making of Modern Economics, The Big Three in Economics, and EconoPower. His financial books include Investing in One Lesson, and The Maxims of Wall Street. In 2006, he compiled and edited The Complete Autobiography by Benjamin Franklin (Regnery).
