During his presentation, he will discuss the following key aspects of bringing his invention to market (1) product development process (2) intellectual property considerations and patenting decisions (3) licensing and manufacturing strategies and (4) market research approaches.

Dr. Majette's background includes (1) 20+ years as a practicing physician specializing in musculoskeletal conditions (2) transitioned from integrated medical practice to inventing innovative orthopedic products (3) developed MyJet Luxopedics concept while seeking solutions for patients and personal travel discomfort and (4) Obtained utility patent for unique cervical support design with Advanced Bracing Technology.

Some of the major milestones involved in his concept to market journey are (1) initially self-funded over \$1 million for R&D and testing (2) handcrafted early prototypes and gathered user feedback (3 launched MyJet Luxopedic Pillow for both medical and consumer markets and (4) expanded product line to include CALM Overlay System for healthcare settings.

Dr. Majette's ongoing efforts include preparing to launch new products under the MyJet Luxopedics brand and expanding applications of existing patents and exploring AI integration.
